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All members of the school community should act as role models for our students, demonstrating attitudes and behaviours that are coherent with the school philosophy, in particular, the following:

1. The staff of The English School are expected to always present a professional appearance within the school premises or when representing the school. Uniforms are provided for Maintenance and General Services staff.
2. Male staff must dress smart casual in trousers (not jeans), long or short-sleeved dress shirts (not polo) and formal jumpers or cardigans. Ties and jackets are expected for formal occasions such as formal school events.
3. Female staff must dress smart casual in blouses, skirts or trousers (not jeans) and cardigans or jumpers. Formal jumpers or jackets may be needed for cold weather and/or formal school events.
4. All staff must avoid clothes that are too revealing (low cut or see through blouses), taking into account the nature of our work with children of all ages.
5. Footwear must be polished. Trainers, sandals or Crocs are not acceptable.
6. For school trips, sporting events, training days, non-uniform days, etc., the dress code will be advised by the Head of Section.
7. PE and Sports teachers are expected to dress sportswear on days that they are teaching and may be required to wear an agreed PE Department sports kit.
8. Special cases for medical reasons should be discussed and agreed with the Head of Section.
9. Special circumstances may be considered by the Heads of Section, based on the nature of the activities.
